3 key points to be communicated from the meeting	
1	Strategic Assessment: presented 4 long term priorities: Drug Misuse, Alcohol Misuse, Young People offending and Adult Re-offending PLUS 3 presenting issues: Violent Crime, Acquisitive Crime and Anti-social behaviour and criminal damage. A major focus is around Public reassurance and confidence.
2	SPP funding pot: various options were circulated and members asked to vote for preferences which resulted in allocation of resource including support for Domestic Violence and Street Pastor training.
3	Communications: this is seen as a priority area to address public confidence and perception of crime. Recent high profile campaigns include 'SAVE DAVE'; during 2010 there will be a focus on positive images of young people.
